

**JURISDICTIONAL GUARDIAN COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIP
RULES & REGULATIONS**

Article I

Section I Qualifications

Members of Job's Daughters and unmarried Majority members, to the age of 28 pursuant to the law, to qualify for the scholarship will make application on the regular application forms to the chairperson of the Scholarship Committee.

Section II Requirements

Applicants will be judged on Scholarship Achievements, Job's Daughters Contributions, Executive Council Recommendation, and 2 Personal Letters of recommendation. (must not be from parents or legal guardians)

G.P.A. of 2.5 or C+ and a score of 70 points are required to receive a scholarship.

Section III Committee Responsibilities

(a) Applicants will be judged by the Jurisdictional Guardian Council Scholarship Committee and the scholarship awarded no later the Installation of the Jurisdictional Council.

(b) Applications must be sent to the Bethels no later than March 1st, of each Jurisdictional Guardian Council of Delaware year, in order that Daughters have sufficient time to complete.
